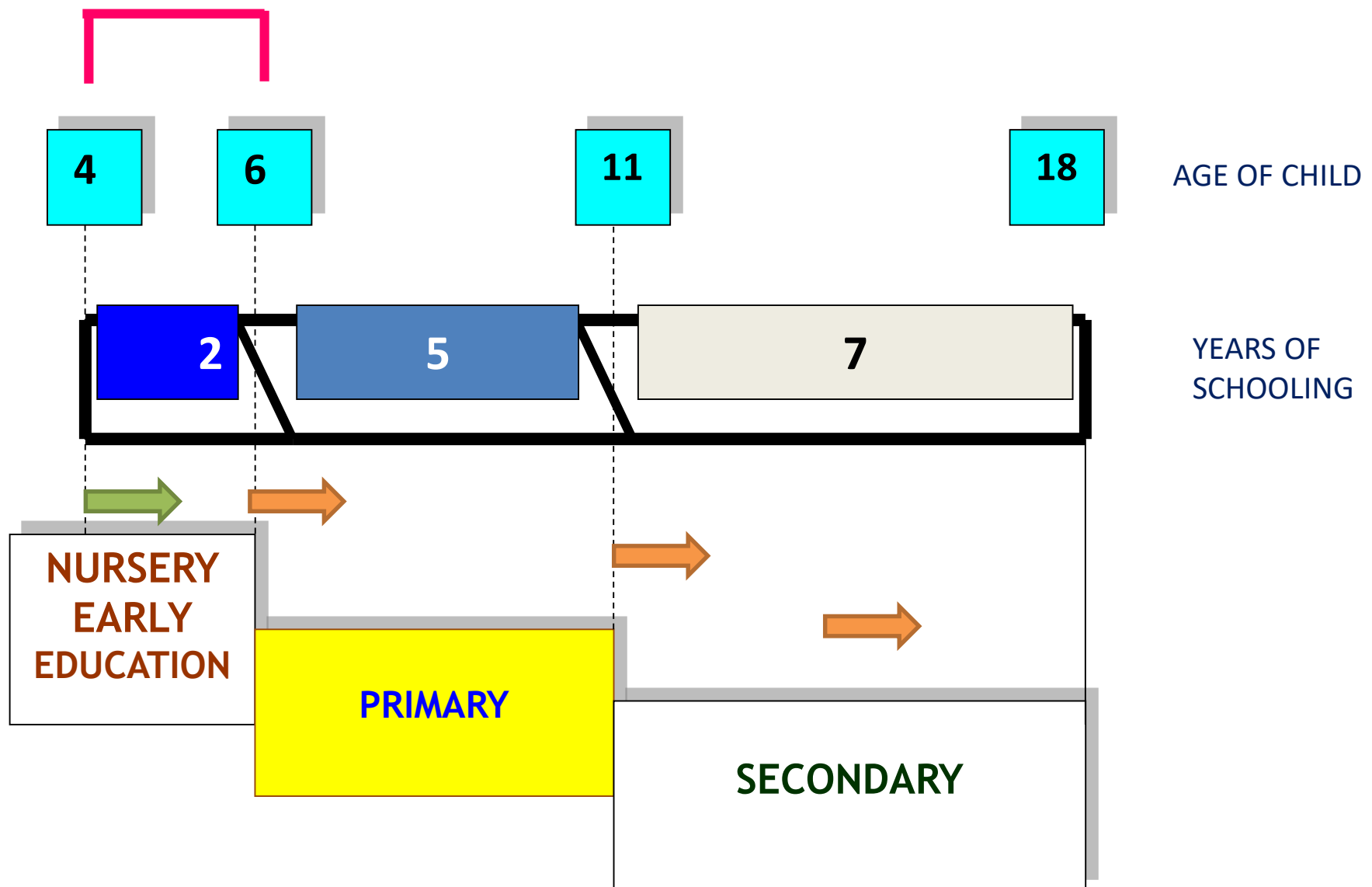

Priorities When Grouping Parallel Classes

- **Priority 1:** Similar numbers in parallel classes
- **Priority 2:** Balanced numbers girls, boys and new students
- **Priority 3:** MTT L1 aspect (grouping the same MTT L1 children in 1 class may be useful)
- **Priority 4:** Pedagogical aspect (it can be useful/necessary to separate children in P1)
- **Priority 5:** Parents' wishes must be based on social and/or language aspects, not on teacher preference.

Class- Size - Regulations

- Max of 30 children per class (mixed age group M1/M2)
- 1 half-time assistant for more than 15 children
- 1 full-time assistant for more than 25 children
