Dear members of the school community,

Although the current situation and the corresponding political decisions both, at the Federal and State level might bring more changes in our everyday life, we expect only few changes for the daily school life. For the period until Christmas the obligation to wear masks in the building and at the seating will remain in force for all Primary and Secondary school pupils, as will the current testing frequency. Should there be any new regulations, we will of course inform you immediately.

The number of positive test results at the school is manageable, the exchange with the Health Department about measures to be taken is very good. So far, we have closed one class in the Primary School for three school days after consultation with the Health Department due to the number of positive cases, but this is rather the exception. The potential closure of a class/group is made only after consultation with the Health Department. Since the beginning of the school year, we have had a total number of cases of infection at the school:

Nursery School:	1
Primary School:	41
Secondary School:	18
Staff:	7

**We will inform you shortly before the Christmas holidays about any changes after the holidays.**

Whether the Standing Commission on Vaccination will release the vaccination for children aged 5 - 11 should be decided in the coming days. This could also be another milestone in the fight against the pandemic. Every individual can make his/her personal contribution to the return to the normal life, albeit perhaps somewhat altered with his/her behaviour and adherence to hygiene rules.

I would like to thank everyone for their tireless commitment to the welfare of the children and young people entrusted to us.
