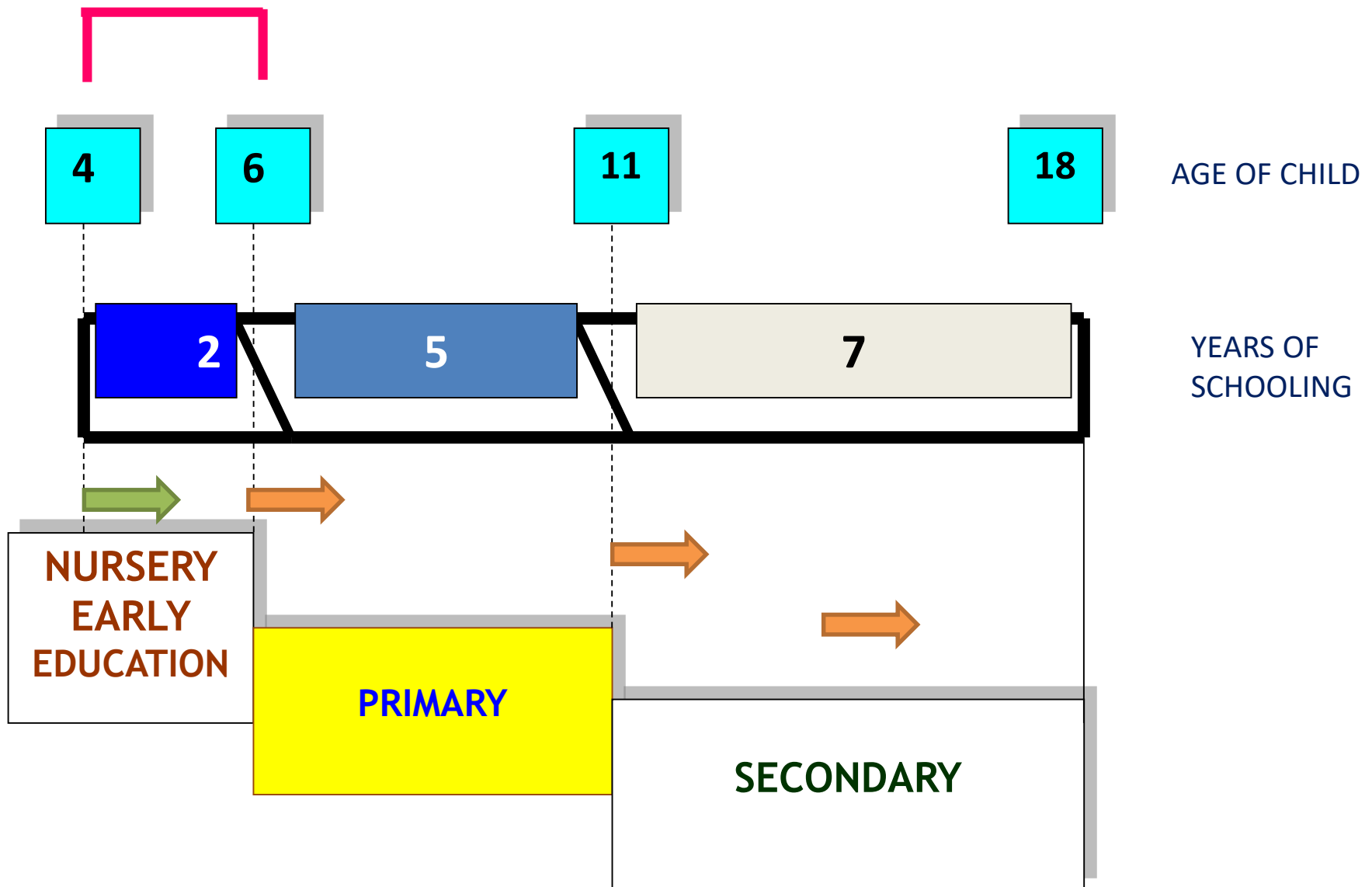

- **Priority 4:** Pedagogical aspect (it can be useful/necessary to separate children in P1)

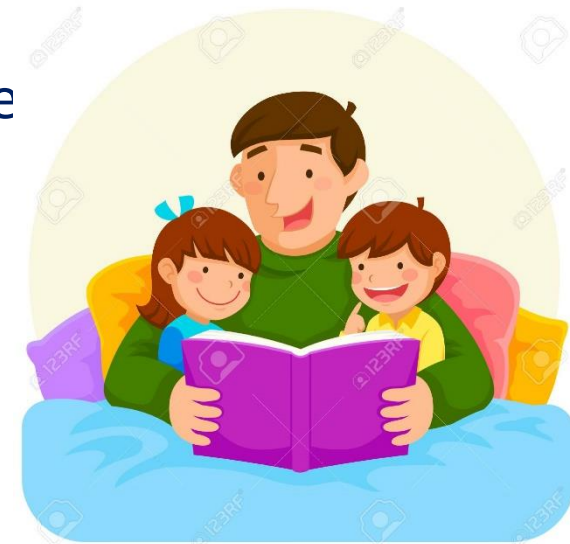
## Class size regulations

- Max of 30 children per class (mixed age group M1/M2)
- 1 Assistant in all Nursery classes

# How to support your child?

# Responsibilities of Parents

- **Absences due to illness**
  - mail to class teacher, doctor's note from 3rd day onwards
- **Mandatory regular school attendance for all N/P pupils**
  - Absences on personal grounds
  - **WRITTEN REQUEST** at least 1 week in advance to the deputy head: 2 days + reasonable time for travelling
  - Permission may not be granted for the week preceding or the week following school holiday periods or public holidays.
- **Communication Policy**
  - Direct (appointment) – each teacher has a Sprechstunde.
  - Email (10 lines max.)
