#### Method of examination for attending students:

- 3) second intermediate test: written multiple choice / or open question test \*:
- 4) final oral exam for students for students who want to be re-interviewed on the first or second part of the program or to improve the grade.
- 5) The intermediate tests, only cover specific parts of the course, RELATED WITH SPECIFIC TOPICS.
- 6) The final exam is an *oral exam* for attending students, who have passed the intermediate tests. Student can students can take the exam on June or Julay or they only can come and register the vote.
