The preliminary mark

given on the final school day before the European Baccalaureate examinations. It is the average mark of all subjects (except Ethics/Religion) and comes from class marks (A1 and A2 marks) and the marks achieved in short and long Pre-Baccalaureate examinations.

The preliminary mark

- The overall preliminary mark's weight is **40%** for the **A mark** and **60%** for the **B mark**. The preliminary mark accounts for **50%** of the final mark of the European Baccalaureate, so it is very important to make a constant effort throughout the whole school year.
- A good preliminary mark will allow students to start the European Baccalaureate examinations with less stress, so it is wise to aim at the highest preliminary mark possible.



Final Mark

- ❖ The final overall European Baccalaureate mark is expressed out of one hundred (100) and is
- ❖ **accurate to two decimal places.** The following 3 factors are taken into consideration for the calculation of the European Baccalaureate final mark:
- ❖ The average preliminary **mark C** expressed out of 100
- ❖ The average written examinations **mark W** expressed out of 100
- ❖ The average oral examinations **mark O** expressed out of 100
- ❖ C, W and O are expressed as numbers with one decimal place.



Final Mark

The proportion of the final total mark for the examination allotted to the various parts will be as follows:

- 50 percent for the average preliminary mark C;
- 35 percent for the average W for the written examinations;
- 15 percent for the average O for the oral examinations;

$$\text{Final result} = 0.50 C + 0.35 W + 0.15 O$$

BAC WRITTEN EXAMS 2026

- Language 1 / Advanced L1
- Language 2 / Advanced Language 2
- Mathematics (3 and 5 periods)
- 2 options (4 periods)

BAC ORAL EXAMS 2026

- Oral exams consist of 20 min. preparation and 20 min. of examination;
- Students will receive individual timetables of their oral exams which include only the time of the actual sitting but not the 20 minute preparation;
- Some oral examiners may be on-line;
- They should arrive in the school 45 minutes before their actual sitting;
- Punctuality, appearance and good manners are crucial;
- Mock Exams.



Beginning and End of Written Examinations

- at 09:00 and 14:00
- Art exam (Saturday): 9.00-14.00 & preparation days
- L1, L2 A and PH4 : 9.00-13.00
- Additional Time:25% i.e. 15 minutes every 60

Students must arrive 20 minutes earlier.

BAC EXAMS 2026 Absences



- Candidates who are absent from an examination with a valid reason will be allowed to re-sit it



- In the event of absence because of illness it is compulsory to present a medical certificate.



Preliminary Mark & BAC Diploma

- All students receive their preliminary mark on the last day of lessons.
- All students irrespective of language section receive a conversion of their BAC marks into the German system
- Students can apply to get their diploma in another european language



Questions about the exam during the exam

- Teachers are not allowed to answer any questions from candidates relating to the examination. The information will be passed on to the BAC coordinator.
- Candidates should continue writing and not waste any time.
- The issue should be raised but a solution/answer should not be expected!

PROCEDURE IN THE EVENT OF CHEATING

EXAMINATIONS

- **Director will be able to award the mark 0 (zero) for the examination in question.**
- **The Discipline Council of the school may be convened at the Director's request and may decide on measures which could lead to exclusion from the Baccalaureate examinations.**

Viewing of Exam Scripts

- Viewing of the European Baccalaureate scripts after marking The candidates or their legal representatives, if they are minors, have the right to view and get a copy of:
- Their original script;
- The final mark awarded to the examination script (average of first and second corrector mark and, where applicable, third corrector mark) ;
- The mark (potential sub-marking: first corrector mark, second corrector mark and, where applicable, third corrector mark) awarded by each one of the correctors
- The correctors' commentaries
- The examination paper
- The marking scheme.

The request must be made in writing to the Director of the School not later than 4 calendar days after the candidates have been informed of the examination results, communicated in accordance with article 7.3. The Director will make all documents available not later than 3 calendar days after receipt of the request. The Director may decide to make all documents available only through a secure electronic form.

A belated request for the viewing of the examination papers will be inadmissible.



ARTICLE 12

COMPLAINTS AND APPEALS

Complaints and appeals concerning the European Baccalaureate examinations must be made through the Director of the School attended by the candidates to the Chairperson of the Examining Board, by the candidates who claim that a procedural irregularity was prejudicial to them, or by their legal representatives if they are minor.

The claim should be made not later than 10 calendar days after communication of the examination results to the candidate, within the meaning of article 7.3.

The Director of the School will send the complaint or appeal, accompanied by all the relevant documentation for the handling of the case, to the Secretary-General of the European Schools.

This must be done electronically not later than 2 working days after the reception at the School. The complaint or appeal will be lodged by the candidates if they have reached the age of majority, or by the legal representative if the candidates are minor — no power of representation, in order to derogate from this provision, being allowed, failing which the complaint or appeal will be declared inadmissible.

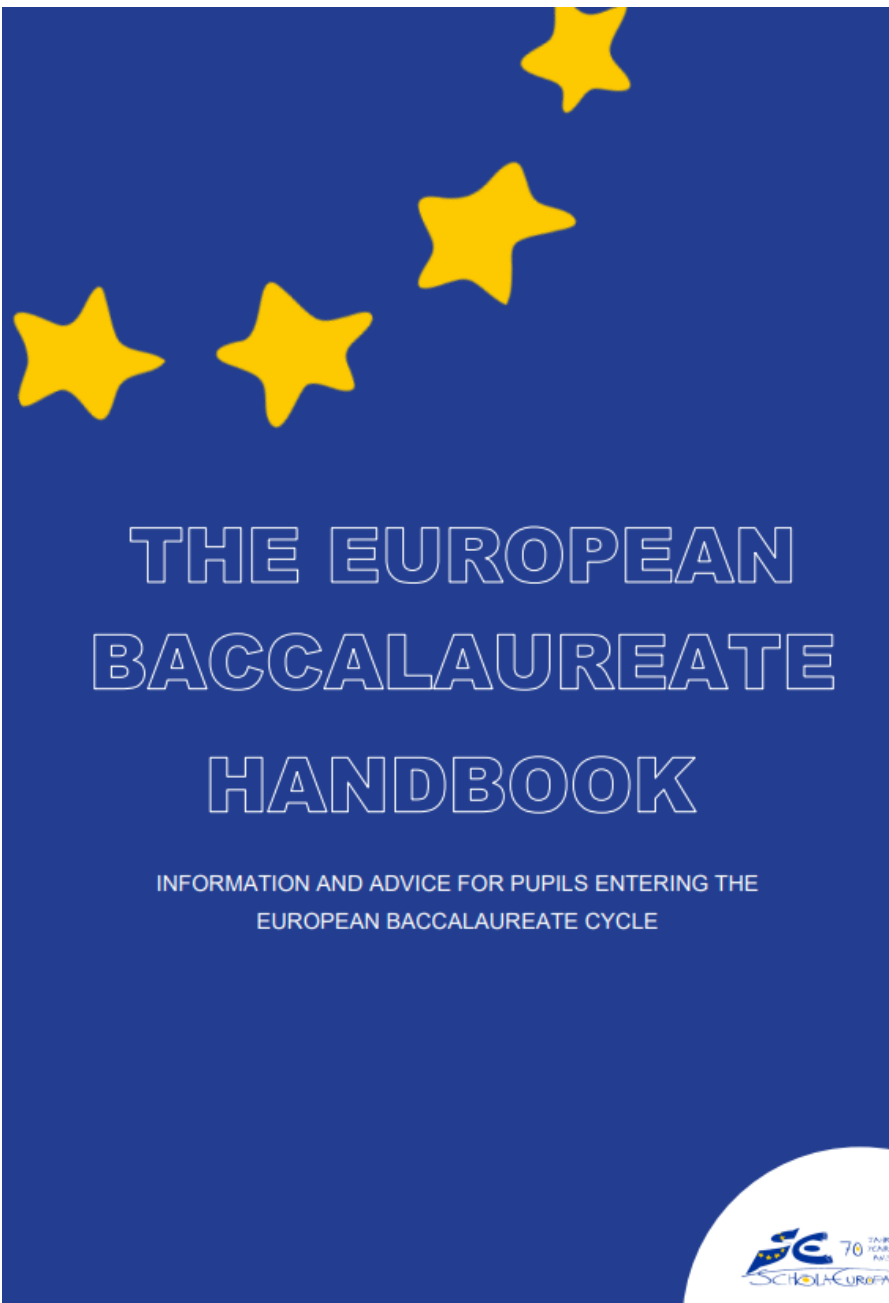
