Dear Parents.

The book lists for the coming school year for all sections are now available on our school website under: <u>Europäische Schule Frankfurt am Main - Booklists (esffm.org)</u>. You are kindly asked to purchase the books as listed (specific to class and language section) for the academic year 2023/2024.

The lists for Languages L2, L3 and L4 can be found under "Foreign Languages".

With regard to English L2/L3, the colleagues teaching English have selected the most modern textbooks which best cover the syllabus in a way which is engaging for students.

All books were readily available on Amazon at the time of the booklist being printed, but some have long order times so please order early.

For S3 and S4 L2 textbooks, Oxford University Press has a sales partner in Germany, Schweitzer Fachinformationen, who sell the books at the RRP unlike. They also offer a 5% discount and more if you order multiple copies. Information on how to order from them is attached.

For pupils with mother tongue tuition different from their language section (SWALS – **S**tudents **W**ithout **A** Language **S**ection), the relevant book lists are the following:

- The respective L1 List
- The German or English Section, different MT (SWALS) List
- The Foreign Languages List

In certain subjects and year groups it is not yet possible to give details of the titles required. In such cases, individual subject teachers will indicate the titles in September, or during the course of the school year.

Teachers for Music and Sports will let you know in a separate letter, which books and/or materials, if any, they would like to use.

The titles listed can be acquired either via a local book shop (recommended for all German titles) or through an on-line provider of your choice.

Both print and e-books can be ordered via Oxford University Press' sales partner in Germany, Schweitzer Fachinformationen. The following discounts are available.

Print books

1 - 9 books: 5% discount10 - 19 books: 10% discount20 books or over: 15% discount

E-books

10% discount on irrespective of quantity ordered

Please note that if books are **not** on stock, delivery can take up to 15 days. The invoice is included with the book(s), to be paid on receipt of goods.
