**STUDENTS' MOBILITY PROGRAMME 2026/2027
APPLICATION SCHOOL YEAR 2025/2026
FOR S4 PUPILS ONLY (exchange taking place in S5 during 2026-2027)**

Dear Parents,

We are happy to inform you that the Mobility Programme will take place in the School Year 2026-2027.

Please note that this Programme is organized only for the S5 class and for those students who are willing to follow the whole 1st Semester of S5, i.e. from the 2nd of September to the 18th of December 2026, in another European School.

We would kindly inform you that:

- Only the students who are currently attending the **S4** can apply for the Mobility Programme.
- Families, whose son/daughter will apply for the exchange programme and are willing to host a student coming from another European School, will be favored.
- The exchange will take place during the whole 1st Semester of the S5, therefore the request for applications for shorter periods won't be taken into consideration.
- The language of the destination country must be one of those studied at school, but not the L1 studied at ESFFM. Given the distribution of the European Schools over the territory, some exceptions may be made on the basis of special conditions and well-reasoned choices and motivations.
- Students participating in the Mobility Programme will take all the exams during the exchange and get their reports and grades from the Host School.

The respective Mobility Coordinators for the ESF are:

1. Mrs **Alexandra Dimou**, Educational Advisor, who is in charge of collecting and sending the applications, as well as for all pedagogical issues and

As of 05.01.2026, the applications will be made **exclusively online**, via an O365 "Forms" that will be made available on the official website of the school, www.esffm.org, under [Europäische Schule Frankfurt am Main - Student Exchanges](#)

Please note that **the form will not be active before 05.01.2026.**

Parents are kindly requested to

1. complete the Mobility Application Form;
2. submit it;
3. print the document;
4. sign it;
5. write an email to the Mobility Coordinator, Mrs Alexandra Dimou, confirming that the form has been submitted. A **scanned (and signed) copy, AS WELL AS a brief personal motivation letter** with a description of the student, his/her interests, and why he/she wishes to apply for the exchange programme, must be attached to the aforementioned email.

Please note that all the information will be treated absolutely confidentially and information about the health of the students will be requested in a separate module in a second time, after the student will have been accepted.

The **DEADLINE** for submitting this application is **16th of January 2026.**

Requests received after that date will not be considered.

The selection procedure of the candidates applied will follow specific criteria:

- 1) The language of the destination country must be one of the subject choices of the applying student;
- 2) The subject choices of the students and their availability in the host school;
- 3) The exchange authorization is subject to approval by the teachers of the applying student;
- 4) No insufficient grades during the current school year;

Please be informed that **a maximum number of participants for each class is set up to 10 % of the number of pupils in the class.**
