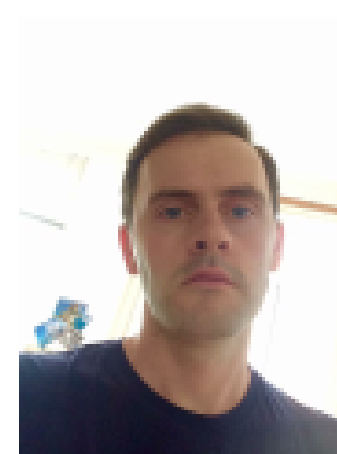

Possible choices S4 & S5

- Economics – 4 periods
- L4 – 4 periods
- ONL: Irish, Maltese – 4 periods
- Ancient Greek – 4 periods
- Art – 2 periods
- Music – 2 periods
- ICT – 2 periods

RESTRICTIONS

- **Only one 4-hour option with Maths 6**
- **Latin and Economics are difficult to combine**
- **Maths 4 & one or two 4 hour options if possible**
- **Changes in timetable/subject choices are not possible between S4 and S5**

POINTS TO TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION

- **Workload**
- **Maths (get in touch with teacher to discuss your option)**
- **Economics (start with it now if you want to continue with it in S6- starting in S6 will not be possible)**
- **NO changes between year 4 and year 5**
- **Restrictions in the creation of a class**
- **Changing choices: extremely difficult**



POINTS TO TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION

- **Restrictions in the creation of a class-minimum of 7 pupils**
- **Think of the possible studies you want to pursue later and talk to your careers teachers if you need specific information**
- **L4 is beginner level**

Digital form

1. Download it and save it to a folder at your pc.
2. When you open it for the first time, first thing to do is to **press the button for enabling the macros** (yellow strip at the top).
3. Fill in the form, press the **validate** button to validate it. Make the appropriate changes till it gets **valid**.
4. Use the **notes** field to write or type a request.
5. When choices are **valid** then use the **print** button to create the pdf file (will be created at the same folder where the file is saved).
6. Print the file, fill in guardian's name/surname and date, sign it, and bring to school before the deadline.
