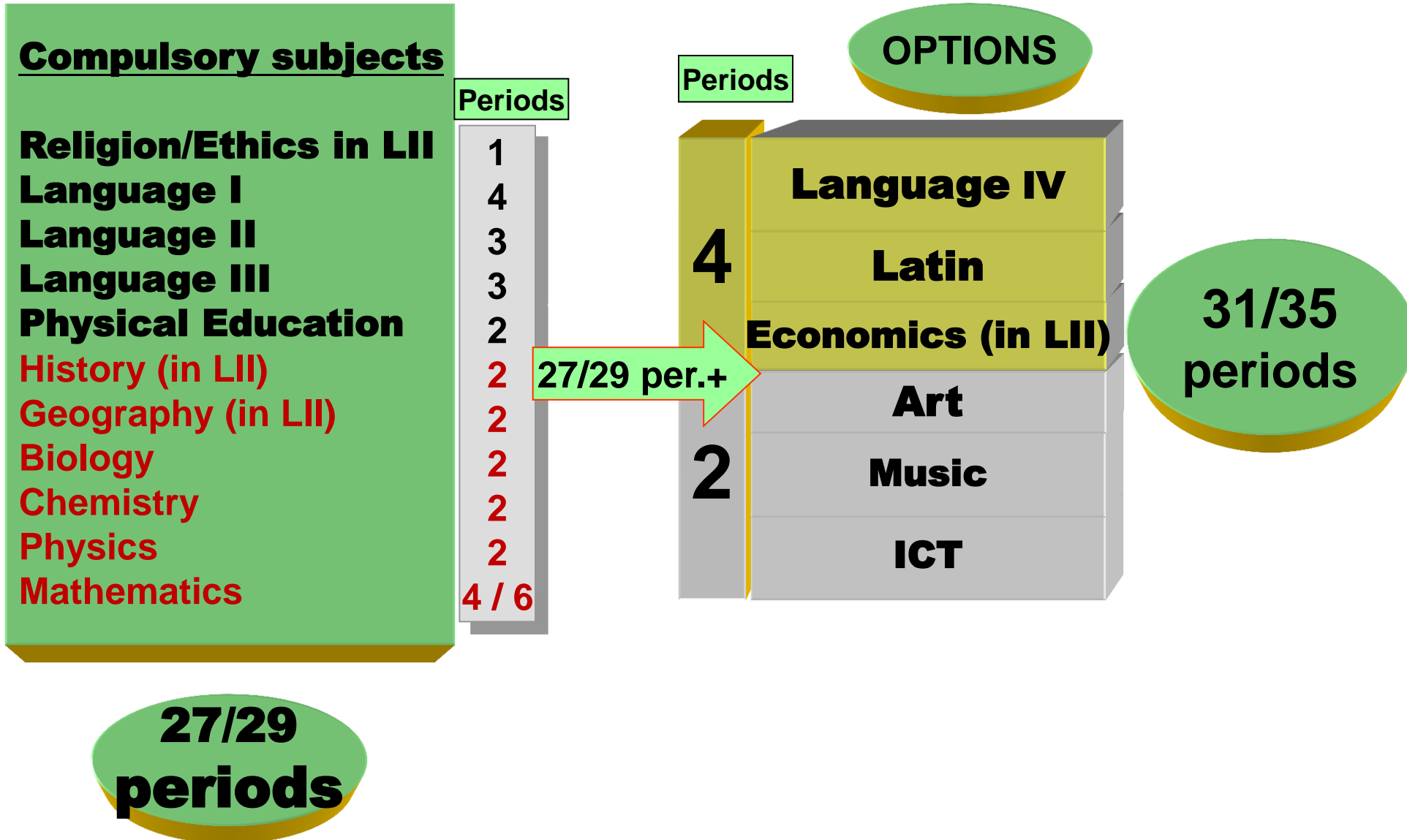

# RESTRICTIONS

- **Only one 4-hour option with Maths 6**
- **No learning support will be offered for Mathematics 6**
- **Latin and Economics cannot be combined**
- **Maths 4 & one or two 4 hour options if possible**
- **Latin might be organised in L2**
- **L4 is a beginners course**
