

The antigen self-testing is carried out by the student. The result should be treated confidentially within the school.

Negative test result in the course of antigen self-testing



The pupil may attend the lessons. Nevertheless, the **hygiene rules** must be observed!

Positive test result in the course of antigen self-testing
A positive test result is not considered a positive diagnosis of Covid 19 disease, but should be considered a suspected case.



Information process: The pupil => the accompanying teacher => the school management => the respective health authority.
School management => Responsible health office



The pupil **cannot continue to attend classes**. The **parents** are **contacted** immediately and pick up the student. The pupil waits in a separate room until he or she is picked up. and is accompanied in a pedagogically sensitive manner. Adult students go home directly. If necessary, the class is also accompanied in an age-appropriate manner.



A free PCR test is mandatory and must be arranged by the parents or the adult student. The parents or the adult student himself/herself must arrange for this test. The appointment is made via the family doctor or one of the test centers (116 117). Until the PCR test result is known, the pupil must go into quarantine.

Negative PCR test result



The pupil is automatically **released from quarantine**. The parents or the adult student inform the school before attending the next in situ lessons.

Positive PCR test result



The pupil **remains in quarantine**. The **respective health authority** will take further steps.
